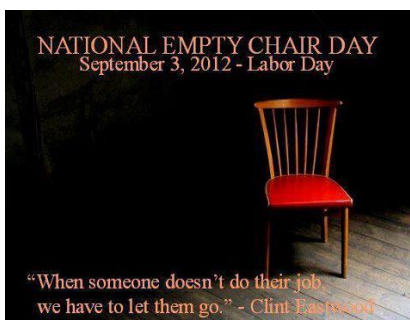

St. Augustine's new "Mobility Plan"

Apparently for months now, our City Commissioners have been investigating several plans for all modes of transportation in and around our city. To increase efficient traffic flow, these plans include an option to manipulate our traffic patterns with one-way entrance corridors, and to remove on-street parking. Other studies wish to create more use of mass transit, promote **carpools**, add bike lanes with 'road diets', and to expand pedestrian trails. This week, running September 17-21 the St. Augustine Mobility Institute is partnering with the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization and the Kansas City, Mo engineering consulting firm of Harrington, Needles, Tammen and Bergendoff. Together (a triangulation), they will evaluate the studies, and propose solutions with input from residents and business owners. Times and locations for these meetings are posted on www.staugustinegovernment.com.



The North Florida Transportation Planning Organization is the independent regional transportation planning agency for Clay, Duval, Nassau and St. Johns counties. Federal Statutes require urbanized areas with 50,000 or more people to have a Metropolitan Planning Organization. The NFTPO Board is comprised of elected officials and transportation agency representatives. A St. Johns County Commissioner (who helped acquire the funds for this review), the City of St. Augustine and the St. Augustine Beach Mayors are members. The NFTPO's goal of "Clean Cities" is to replace petroleum used in the transportation sector with alternative

fuels; reduce petroleum use by promoting fuel-efficient, advanced technology vehicles, and to reduce petroleum or other fuel use by creating the use of mass transit, carpools and biking to work. Thus reducing congestion and harmful auto emissions. Greenhouse gas emissions can also be tracked, measured, and logged on their website.

It sounds nice enough, but all the green words that these agencies use (above) are right out of the ICELI website: www.ecomobility.org/home/features-of-an-ecomobile-city. Eco-Mobility: Cities built for People,

SATP Files Law Suit Against Its Former Leadership

The Saint Augustine Tea Party has filed suit in County Court against Republican State Committeeman Randy Covington and two conspirators, Eric West, Recording Secretary of the REC and Edith Russo. Also included in the suit is the Wells Fargo Bank.

While in the process of incorporating the St. Augustine Tea party, Inc., Eric West, the incorporator, only put two of the newly elected officers of the Tea Party on the Corporate papers; Eric West, who filed the papers with the Secretary of State, did not put on the other elected officer, but switched the duly elected Esther Miller, to the unelected, Randy Covington. To add to the conspiracy to injure, private, separate money was used to incorporate this bogus entity; not Tea Party funds.

The exact nature of this alleged fraud was kept from the Tea Party membership. For close to an entire year, Randy Covington and Eric West stalled and balked at having any corporate organizing Board meetings as required by State Statute 617. Membership definitions, bylaws and the election and/or appointment of Officers to the corporation were avoided.

The final straw was when Randy Covington and Eric West sent a messenger, to the weekly Tea Party Committee meetings, with talking points from Republican Party. By this time it was clear to the 'Grassroots Members', that Randy Covington and Eric West constituted a conflict of interest between the GOP and the Tea Party movement.

The membership voted to reject this Republican takeover of the Saint Augustine Tea Party. The struggle for control was reported in the St. Augustine Record and this publication. The Saint Augustine Tea Party, which continued to meet at the Village Inn, voted out Eric West and fought off the Republican activists who attempted to control or destroy the 'Grassroots Tea Party'. This struggle was not between Tea Parties, but between a Tea Party and 'Republican Operatives'.

I suspect that many of us did not realize that in Florida our Supreme Court justices have to periodically run on the November ballot to get a "yes" or a "no" as to whether they should be kept on the court. They are NOT appointed for life as are Federal judges. The 3 judges on the ballot are extremely liberal. They were appointed before a Republican held the governor's office.

During this divide, Treasurer Lance Thate, put a hold on the Tea party funds at the Wells Fargo Bank. Randy Covington and Eric West then, without legal notice, tried to fire Lance Thate as Treasurer and install one, Edith Russo as Treasurer and then removed \$6250, from the Wells Fargo Bank. The Plaintiffs are suing Wells Fargo Bank for failing to notify Lance Thate, the duly elected Treasurer and for failing to use 'due diligence' in transferring the funds.

Lance Thate said, "We have done everything in our power to straighten this thing out. We have talked to Lenny Curry, Florida GOP Chairman and Harlan Mason, St. Johns REC Chairman, REC Board Members and Wells Fargo Bank. But to no avail." "They simply did nothing. Numerous attempts at discussions were rejected. Therefore, we are forced, in the interests of our membership, to take legal action," added Lance Thate

Professor Joseph Olson of Hamline University School of Law in St. Paul, Minnesota, points out some interesting facts concerning the last Presidential election:

Number of States won by: Obama: 19 McCain: 29

Square miles of land won by: Obama: 580,000 McCain: 2,427,000

Population of counties won by: Obama: 127 million McCain: 143 million

Murder rate per 100,000 residents in counties won by: Obama: 13.2 McCain: 2.1
