It was reported today that, at a general business meeting held on March 4, 2014, the officers of the St. Augustine Tea Party (SATP) were



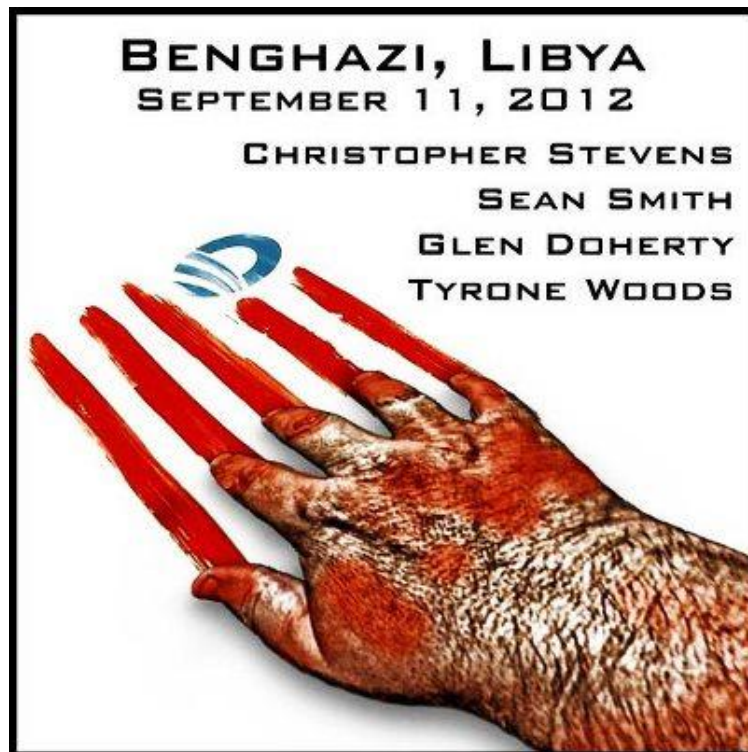

authorized to proceed with the acquisition of the replica float known as the Dartmouth. [The original Dartmouth was one of three ships, in the Boston Harbor, from which tea was thrown overboard by the "Sons of Liberty" on December 16, 1763 Ed.] In the early days of the Tea Party movement, the modern day replica of the Dartmouth made many appearances in parades and rallies in Northeast Florida and Georgia. It also made trips to Washington, DC during the massive Tea Party rallies held in 2009 and 2010 in the Nation's Capital. The Dartmouth was constructed by an early Tea Party activist, Glenn Lord Sr. The St. Augustine Tea Party took possession on March 7, 2014. It was transported late in the day from Jacksonville, FL. to St. Augustine. In spite

## The fourth annual St. Patrick's Day parade in St. Augustine

The fourth annual St. Patrick's Day parade, in St. Augustine, Florida, was held on March 8, 2014. Parade participants report that the parade was well organized. On March 5, 2014, a well attended organizational meeting, was conducted by Sherri Cunningham. From the St. Augustine Tea Party's (SATP) perspective, the parade went off as planned. Parade Marshals were most helpful and reported that there were twice as many floats as the previous year. As the various floats passed the reviewing stand, it was noted that there was a large attending audience at the reviewing stand location. As the Dartmouth and the SATP's walking contingent passed the people assembled at the reviewing stand, it received a large, warm and approving round of applause from the public. The applause never stopped along the parade route, but it was in less intensity because the parade was not attended as well as previous St. Patrick's Day parades. At some points along the way, there were few or no

persons on the street or sidewalks. This reporter concludes that forecasts of temperatures in the 40s in the early morning and the fact that the parade was scheduled so far in advance from the actual St. Patrick's Day accounted for the reduced attendance. Those in attendance and the participants in the parade all seemed to have had a very good time in what turned out to be a delightful day.

## Is the Tea Party movement in decline?

The SATP likes to engage in St. Augustine's parades as it allows the group to assess local acceptance. On St. George Street, the SATP's Town Crier Committee engages a national audience. While visitors are present for parades, large numbers of locals are also present.

The SATP has participated in three of the last four parades. The first St. Patty's Day parade in St. Augustine occurred on March 12, 2011. The parade was extensive and the crowds were large and robust. A Tea Party member, who was present, reports that he witnessed from the bow of the Dartmouth that the Tea Party presence was enthusiastically embraced by the crowds. However, the GOP float, which was directly in front of the Dartmouth, received only a polite response. The idea that the Tea Party had grown beyond meetings and rallies and was now a movement in the minds of the people first occurred at this event. [At the time most Tea Parties were controlled by the Republican Party] A spokesman for the Tea Party revealed that from this observation, over a period of several months, the members of the SATP began taking the Tea Party's message to the streets. "It should be pointed out that the Republican leadership of the SATP, at the time, was just as concerned that the Tea Party would damage the GOP image as the leadership of the Republican National Committee is today," a Tea Party person said. "Our GOP leadership actually told us we could not use Gadsden Flags in parades as it might offend someone."

With 12 Gadsden flags flying, and new SATP leadership, the SATP participated in their second St. Patrick's Day parade on March 10, 2012. The Dartmouth was not available for this parade as its owner and builder, Glenn Lord, had relocated. A float featuring "Betsy Ross" was created by Cindy Falco, SATP Events Chairman at the time. Cindy has since relocated to South Florida and continues her good work there. But her float and the Tea Party were well accepted at the second annual St. Patrick's Day parade, according to the Tea Party members who were at the event.

When asked about today's event and how it differed from the prior events, a Tea Party member answered, "Well, today we had more people present than we've had before. We had fewer rejections and it appeared that there was greater support. We had mostly new faces on board and walking. And we had more young people than before. We also had people, who are not active Tea Party members, joining us because they wanted to be associated with the Tea Party movement." He continued with, "When you do good works and you tell the truth, good things just come to you. So it is with the Dartmouth. We are honored to have Mr. Lord entrust the Dartmouth to our 'grassroots' Tea Party. Its construction had to be a labor of love and dedication to the 'Liberty Movement'. By the way, to the progressives out there, the 'Koch Brothers' did not fund it. That will be accomplished by individuals who love Liberty. To anyone who has any doubts about the Tea Party movement growing and expanding, come join us; it is a site to behold, HOORAH!"

## Media failure

### The 'Printed Press' has failed its Constitutional responsibility, The St Augustine Record is complicit

The St. Augustine Tea Party has long held the view that what happens at a local level is a microcosm of what happens at a national level. This is true as it pertains to government and the 'Fourth estate'. It is widely reported and understood that establishment media, both broadcast and print, manipulate the news to the advantage of the current power structure. Our founding fathers understood that in order for the Republic to survive, a free and independent press is necessary. They provided for a free press in the First Amendment to the Constitution of the United States. The Free Press function is now being carried on by Internet publications.

It was reported, today, by the St. Augustine Tea Party (SATP) that its local newspaper, The St. Augustine Record, has been complicit in distorting the news about the Tea Party here. "The corruption of the print media is grievously apparent. They do it through misrepresentation of facts, distortions, in the selection of what is news and by ignoring and excluding us from coverage. The St. Augustine Tea Party has been a victim of The Record's manipulation of facts since the Tea Party's inception. Recently, the Tea Party's 36 foot long 'float' in the St. Patrick's Day Parade, was not pictured among the 126 photos on the Record's web edition. This is

nothing new,” said Dave Heimbold, SATP Media Chairman. “Excluding the prize winning Dartmouth Float was not an accident and is reflective of their fear of the Tea Party.” The Pedro Menendez HS Marching Band, which preceded the Tea Party, and the St Francis House marchers were included. It should be noted that the Tea Party received continuous applause along the parade route, according to Tea Party members on the float.

“The Record is a propaganda rag of the Left,” continued Heimbold. “After it emerged from bankruptcy a few years back, there was hope that the editorial slant would be replaced with at least ‘middle of the road’ reporters. Unfortunately, that was not the case. The last straw was the unsigned Editorial, “Laughing in the Face of the St. Augustine Tea Party, by Peter Ellis. This was a raw, slanderous attack on the Town Criers, who are adored by the vast majority of those who visit St. Augustine’s St. George Street. Americans, tourists and Communist-exiles from Cuba, Venezuela, and former Soviet East European slave States love the Tea Party. The latter have experience living under Communism. They identify with the veracity of the sign, Obama Is A Communist because they have experienced Communism and they recognize it happening here. Now, the American people are beginning to experience Communism, first hand, under Obama and his Czars.

“After bankruptcy the Record didn’t change. It got considerably worse!” said Dave Heimbold. Continuing, he listed a litany of abuses. “Remember the abuse and the Civil Rights violation of the vets at the WW2 Memorial in Washington, D.C. by the Obama Administration? Well, this abuse of patriots had been going on here in St. Augustine at the Castillo de San Marcos, for 2 years. The abuse was topped when Town Criers, in 1776 outfits for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration and Fireworks at the Fort, were stopped by a Park Ranger and given a Federal Citation for not having a ‘special permit’ to celebrate the 4<sup>th</sup> of July with the other 15,000 people on the fort grounds awaiting the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks! This blatant act of Civil Rights violation was e-mailed immediately to the new publisher of The St. Augustine Record Newspaper, Delinda Vogel and her staff. They ‘spiked’ the story. [Refused to print it] However, Action News 47 in Jacksonville heard about it and ran with it, plus a follow up story that went out to 13 Counties and millions of viewers in Northeast Florida. Because of the publicity of the singling out of the Tea Party, by the Park Rangers at the Fort, the Supervisor of the Castillo, Gordy Wilson, dropped the charge. Plus, offended Tea Party patriots met with Gordy Wilson at the Fort, culminating in the restoration of first Amendment rights to the ‘Fort grounds’. This was never reported by the Record.” Currently, these Civil Rights Abuses have been taken to Washington, D.C. via the office of Rep. Ron DeSantis, District 6<sup>th</sup> of Florida. Preliminary inquiry has been made of the Dept. of Interior. The Obama Administration is stonewalling it, like every other abuse of the Veterans and patriots, such as the Tea Party. The Record has not reported this local Civil Rights violation or the action by Rep. DeSantis’ office.

The conclusion of the matter is that The St. Augustine Record Newspaper is a propaganda piece of the Left. Jim Sutton, former Publisher of the Record is back from being the ‘fishing guy’ for the Florida Times Union, another Morris Communications Leftist rag. Sutton returned to ‘help’ temporarily. Now two more reporters are being added to the deck of the Titanic. Cutting the size of the paper and charging more is not going to help the Record. Telling ‘the rest of the story’ might. The Town Criers took to the streets of the historic district of St. Augustine, Florida, where it engages a national audience, for the 120<sup>th</sup> time this weekend. It is estimated that 7500 people experienced their signs and flags. During their exposure, large numbers of photographs are taken by the public. The Criers take sample pictures



of those who interact with them. The photographs reveal that the majority of participants were of millennial age and that female participation exceeded the male and elderly participation combined.

On “Meet the Press”, during the interview by Andrea Mitchell with Jimmy Carter, Carter expressed the view that the number one civil rights issue in the world is the

abuse of women's rights. However, the left is very selective in distinguishing between which women they will defend. If a woman is a Conservative, such as Sarah Palin for example, they get crucified. ## **Common Core's Marxist assault on our youth**

On March 25, 2014, the Saint Augustine Tea Party (SATP) held its second 'Open' speaker meeting for the month. The group meets on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month. The featured speaker, returning for the third time, was William Korash. Mr. Korash is the publisher of The Report Card. His on-line publication focuses on educational issues and he reported that the site is getting an average of 39,000 hits per month. Mr. Korash also serves as St. Johns County Republican Executive Committee's First Vice Chairman.

According to Korash, David Coleman, the acknowledged "architect" of Common Core Standards, is busy rewriting PSATs and SATs to fall into line with his Common Core Standards. Coleman is the head of the College Board. Korash pointed out that Coleman has been associated with Bill Ayres.

This Communist association was visually disturbing to the people in attendance. David Coleman's connection to Weather Underground bomber, Bill Ayers, was not acceptable to the SATP members. "Ayers appointed Barack Obama to head the Chicago Annenberg Challenge. No, Ayers wasn't "just a guy in the neighborhood" as Obama claimed when he was running for President. He and Ayers shared an office for three years, and cheated the children of Chicago out of millions of dollars of educational funding. A significant amount went to Ayers' Small Schools Workshop for ethnic projects. The priorities like math and reading were left wanting. Korach went on to disclose that new textbooks on history have a world view. American history is being rewritten to exclude American achievements and focuses on “victimhood based on Race, Class and Gender”. It is what white men did to the Indians, the Blacks and women. Gone are the founding fathers, with only a brief mention of George Washington. The Constitution of the United States is not being presented with any detail. The sacrifices of those who died in the various conflicts preserving liberty are excluded. Mr. Korash reported that only 12% of high school students have a sufficient knowledge of history. “The willful destruction of a culture is a clear indication of a domestic Communist attack,” a ‘cold war’ Tea Party member said.

Korash said he has all but given up on the local St. Johns School Board. The school board claims that their decisions are now in the hands of the State of Florida, the Federal government. William Korash said, " A solution to restore excellence in the public schools is found in Charter Schools, which are still public schools but without the teachers unions.”

When the rain eased up to a light drizzle, the Criers took off on foot from the Village Inn to the historical district. Immediately, the gloom of the soggy start lifted, as car after car passed the Criers beeping their horns and waving thumbs up. Yes, there was ‘Singing in the Rain’ because, again, even in the rain, pictured top right, a cross section of the American people proved that the Tea Party Movement is loved, respected and is expanding! The Town Criers, in St. Augustine, have the pulse of “We the People” every weekend and report back to you, the political vibrations that they pick up. Because of the weather, the stream of tourists was less; only about 4000 to 5000 people saw us. Hundreds took pictures of our messages and

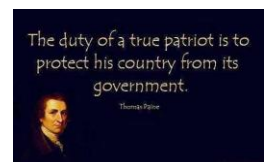
posted them on the Internet. The Town Criers engaged about 40-50 groups in conversation. The public's response was explosive in spite of the rain.

1. Criers left the Village Inn at 1:30PM and immediately were cheered by beeping horns and thumbs up;
2. Cheered along the way towards St. George street by families at the playground, on Francis Field;
3. Encountered a family who lived under Communism in Czechoslovakia. The mother said, "We left Communist Czechoslovakia in 1986 to come here (USA) and now Communism is coming here";
4. A Tea Party leader from Massachusetts reported to the Criers a steady increase of 'friends on Facebook'. It is up 40% since September. He was amazed at the attention the Criers got from the tourists and the numerous pictures being taken;
5. Millennial generation engaging the Criers continued as noted in the past weeks;
6. Hundreds of tourists asked to hold our anti-Obama signage, then posted their own pictures on Facebook, congratulating themselves on their courage for doing so;
7. A group of about 20-25 blacks engaged the Criers with mindless chants of "Obama! Obama! Obama!"
8. The highlight of the day was a bus load of Hispanic tourists from Miami who ran towards the Town Criers chanting "Tea Party! Tea Party! Tea Party! Tea Party!"





# The truth about minorities

## What the two political parties don't talk about

The concept of the “Democratic Plantation” is never discussed by either party. Lyndon Baines Johnson’s (LBJ) “Great Society” marked the turning point for Afro-American voting patterns. Prior to the Progressive’s “Great Society” black people tended to vote Republican in greater numbers. The Democratic Party in those days attracted supporters of racist ideologies, such as the KKK. Consider LBJ’s comments regarding the people he professed to be helping:

*“These Negroes, they’re getting pretty uppity these days and that’s a problem for us since they’ve got something now they never had before, the political pull to back up their uppityness. Now we’ve got to do something about this, we’ve got to give them a little something, just enough to quiet them down, not enough to make a difference..... I’ll have those niggers voting Democratic for the next 200 years.” —LBJ*

“Fortunately, those days are behind us,” a Town Crier spokesman commented. “However, the destruction of family values, the abortions of black babies and economic enslavement prevail as a consequence of progressive programs directed at the poor,” he concluded. According to the Common Sense Conspiracy website, “... the concept of the Democratic Plantation is not about political parties, despite the name. It is about the system of government and what their true mission is. The “enslavement” that is suggested by the Democratic Plantation, no longer applies to just African Americans, but to all Americans. If you are not part of the rich elite, you are at risk for being part of the plantation. It’s no longer about color of skin, racism, or bigotry. It’s about a New World Order, a state of control and the concept that patriotism is no longer a feeling of pride for your country, but a feeling of loyalty to a government that provides for you.”

The Town Criers report that, for the past three years, their engagement with blacks in the historic district has been less than they would like. The majority of black people simply ignore the Tea Party presence. It is assumed that they are loyal to Obama. Today, a group of 20 to 25 blacks engaged the Tea Party to show their support of Obama’s ‘plantation’. It appeared to be a group of tourists who had just disembarked from a trolley and were on St. George Street, for no other purpose than to enjoy the sights. Over the chants of, “Obama, Obama, Obama” a woman declared, “I’m ready for it, I’m ready for Communism!” The Town Criers were carrying a sign which defined Obama’s Communist Goals. It should be noted, however, that the number of blacks responding favorably to the Tea Party values has been increasing. “We pray that they will be freed from their economic enslavement,” the Criers said. It is interesting to report that within several minutes the Town Criers encountered another group of minorities with a completely different experience.



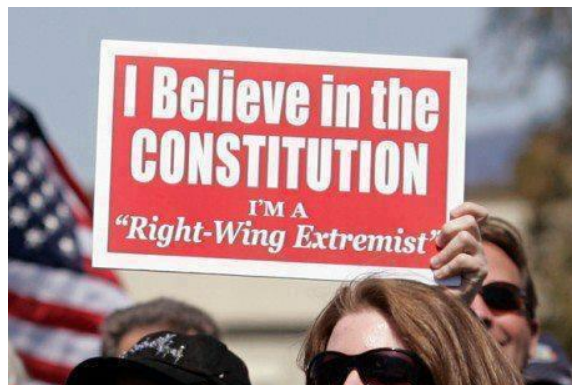
