Bolivian Author Warns Tea Party about Communist Infiltration



Tea Party Ten Years and Counting

In the coming month, the Tea Party movement will observe its Tenth Anniversary. The modern day Tea Party began with a rant from Rick Santelli during a live broadcast from the floor of the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. The CNBC business news editor criticized the government's plan to refinance mortgages and called for a new Tea Party event such as occurred in

Boston in 1773. A new Tea Party, if you will. The broadcast occurred on February 19, 2009.

By tax day, April 15, 2009, the birth of the populist Tea Party movement had gathered strength. There were rallies across the country. The Christian Science Monitor, at the time, reported rallies in 750 cities with an estimated half a million people attending.

The Tea Party's massive populist appeal and their ability to attract millions, almost immediately became the focus of Republican Party operatives. The populist movement generated enthusiasm that the Republicans have never been able to create. And so it was with the grassroots group in St. Augustine, known as "Just Patriots", which later, became the St. Augustine Tea Party (SATP).

The exact number of Tea Party groups that formed in Florida back then is unknown for sure, but estimated to be a few hundred. What is known is that 83 Tea Parties formed a network in 2010. Republican operatives took control of The SATP in August 2010 and later the Tea Party Network, as well.

Tea Parties were used for the express purpose of electing Republicans. And for a while that seemed to be a solution to stopping the Progressive Communist agenda. The Tea Party people were a little naïve. But it is now clear that Republican leaders are about "Big Government" and have little concern for the Constitution. The Tea Parties, on the other hand, are about small government, free enterprise, capitalism and adherence to the Constitution. So, there is a problem, a big problem.

By 2011, members of the SATP understood that there was more to the movement then electing Republicans. This Tea Party divorced themselves from the Republican control. To our knowledge, they are one of the few Tea Parties to accomplish this and still remain viable. Republican dirty tricks operatives did their best to destroy the SATP. It wasn't until the SATP took them to court, several years later, that the matter was laid to rest.

During the 2012 election campaign, GOP State Committeeman and Committeewomen met in Tallahassee to deal with the subject of "Control or Destroy Tea Party" groups. Republicans did not like Tea Party candidates. They tended to come from outside the party structure. They also were inclined to be less controllable. The neoconservatives of the Republican Party have been relatively successful. Today there are only a handful of Tea Parties that are active and functioning in Florida. Florida's experience is reflected across the whole Country.

While the Republican leadership was successful in taking the Tea Party out of the conversation on mainstream media, including Fox News, they have not been successful in removing the memory of the Tea Party from the people. They experience the affection of the people when the Town Criers make appearances on St. George Street. People are energized by the Tea Party presence. And the Republicans got something they didn't expect in 2016. The GOP thought they were getting rid of the Tea Party, but what they got was Donald J. Trump.

The legacy of the Tea Party movement today is the Republican "Freedom Caucus" and the 45th President of the United States. If you are familiar with the Tea Party rallies of old and you attend a Trump rally today you will see some similarities.

On October 24, 2015, then candidate, Donald Trump came to Florida campaigning for the first time. He held a rally at "The Landing" in Jacksonville, Florida. The event was organized by Billie Tucker, the former Chairman of the First Coast Tea Party. The Landing had been the site of numerous Tea Party rallies.

What was missing from the largely Tea Party crowd that was in attendance, was their original signs and their flags. All vestiges of the Tea Party were wiped away by a prohibition of any original signs or flags by the Trump organization. Members of this Tea Party were denied entrance with their 10 full-size Gadsden flags. To paper over the Tea Party movement with the Silent Majority, had to be the creation of a Republican operative. No one else could be so out of touch with the reality of the American people. Prior to Trump's appearance, an MC tantalized the audience with some of the early Tea Party rhetoric and music, songs that were written exclusively for Tea Party rallies.

Well folks, "Trump Rallies" still reflect the Tea Party rallies minus the flags and the signs. The Tea Party never had a leader in its beginning, but it does now. The Tea Party was a pain in the butt to the Republican establishment. And it still is, in the person of Donald Trump.

It is ironic that the Republican Party leadership does not support their President. It disturbing that Trump Clubs are reluctant to engage the public by showing support for 45 in the streets. There must be millions of MAGA hats in circulation. But, you never see them among the public. They are reserved for political meetings

of like-minded people. The Main Stream Media has convinced people not to wear them. People who are fearful about wearing MAGA hats in public today, will be terrified in the future if the Cultural War continues to be inflicted by the Progressive Communists, resulting in their taking permanent power.

The SATP and its action committee, the Town Criers, have been engaging in the "Cultural War" since the very beginning of the Town Crier existence. The SATP reports that it is fortunate to have the historic district in their locale. It gives the Town Criers a forum to present ideas, but more importantly, to observe the public's reaction. One of their activities is the conducting of polls. The "St. George Street Poll" is a random selection, face-to-face poll. The SATP has been conducting polls since 2012.

They have had some interesting perspectives to present. In January 2012, they predicted, based on the public's reaction, that Mitt Romney would be the Republican nominee and that he would fail in the general election. In February 2016 they predicted that Donald J Trump would be President of the United States, and it didn't matter whether the Republicans nominated him or not.

The St. George Street pollsters do not claim that their polls are scientific. But they do claim that they are honest and direct. There is something about the demographics on St. George Street which permits them to forecast political outcomes. True to their tradition, the Town Criers conducted a poll this past Saturday. The question was simple enough, "Wall or No Wall?" By a margin of 2 to 1 the public demanded the wall be built.

When asked about the future of the Tea Party, Lance Thate, SATP Chairman had this to say;

"There is an evil across the land and it is defined by the Progressive Communists. As Town Criers of old, it is our duty to alert and awaken the Country. The "Cultural War" is real and deadly. This war must be won. We are close to living in a police state. The proof was shown by the FBI terror tactics against Roger Stone. The message was that we should all stand down. Well, we're not going to stand down and it will be the Tea Party's function to show the way, as it did in 2010. A young high school student wearing a MAGA hat and standing his ground against a "Communist Operative" should give us all the direction we need to act. 
