A Brother's Story

My oldest brother, Thomas, was an engineer and was selected for Tau Beta Pi, the engineering honor society. I had a brother who was three or four years younger but he died at the age of four of spinal meningitis. It was a fulminate case and took him in just 24 hours.

My next brother, Richard, also received an engineering degree, later went to law school and entered the bar. My next brother, John, fell out of a third story window, also around the age of four, fractured his skull and was nearly killed. He wound up brain damaged with a variable IQ that could fall into the retarded range and had poor motor co-ordination. I was the youngest of my family and became a physician. Our sister was about four years younger than John and eight older than I.

Growing up was painful for me, to a large degree due to John; we called him Jack. Jack was eleven years older than I and I saw him struggling to play softball and the other games the neighborhood kids played in the heart of Manhattan. Children can be cruel, both intentionally and unintentionally. He was often ridiculed and called names, those were some of the intentional things but the unintentional may have hurt more. He was often told to get our sister to play because 'she plays better than you do.' It was hard seeing that.

As I grew up, it wasn't too long before I was outperforming him in every game; softball, stickball, football, basketball, etc., all the staples of city life but Jack never complained or displayed any resentment of it nor for my academic achievements that quickly outstripped his.

Jack's condition left him with few employment options. I'm not even sure if he ever received a high school diploma or G.E.D. He was always the last hired and first fired but every time he was let go, the very next day, he'd be looking for a job, checking the help wanted columns, pounding the pavement or revisiting old connections.

He did what many would call menial jobs. They were not even custodial jobs but usually courier positions. Occasionally, he would land a job in a company mail room which would be a huge step up for him because he

wouldn't have to be toddling around New York City, exposed to deep cold, inclement weather of the city's winters and its hot, humid summers.

His compromised mental and physical condition left him spurned as he entered his courting years but he finally married when he was nearly forty years old. It was during those years, the early 1970s, that the economy floundered and he, once again, entered the ranks of the unemployed. As was characteristic, he immediately began, unsuccessfully, looking for work but to no avail for weeks and months and his wife was the household bread winner.

Jack was unemployed so long that, our brother, Dick, the lawyer, finally went to him and told him that he couldn't go on much longer and that he should apply for some kind of public assistance, welfare. Dick offered to help him with the paperwork.

Jack then went to our mother and told her about it and said he just didn't want to go on welfare. He never did and finally, after a while longer, did find a job.

With two brothers being engineers, one of them an attorney and the other a physician, there can be little doubt that Jack's life was made markedly worse due to his injury. Yet through all his incapacity and the suffering, personal and emotional, Jack never went on welfare.

Now ask me about welfare.

Confederate Memorial Day Conversations

Friday May 10, 2019 would mark Confederate Memorial Day in North Carolina. I think that I must still be around there hugging on her.

I am saddened to hear that a Memorial to the last living member of the Tuskegee Airmen was vandalized at a black history museum in Winter Park, Florida. Not surprising, though, because Orlando was the first Confederate Cenotaph to be debased and desecrated by removal.

The Honorable Attorney Kirk D. Lyons of the Southern Legal Resource Center who gave the Keynote speech at

the graveside ceremony in the slave section of the Taylor family cemetery, more than a decade ago; would warn of the slippery slope on the attacks of all things Confederate. His prophecy has come to fruition as George Soros and his well funded domestic terrorist have ramped up their program of social and cultural genocide against the whole of America.

Fox Town Hall: Socialism at 47%



Fox Business News, on September 17th 2019, featured a highly advertised Town Hall meeting between Capitalists and Socialists. People's right to the First Amendment

Our next business meeting will be on June 4, 2019. Our next open meeting will be on June 11 2019. The Featured speaker will be Paul Livingston. He will be speaking on Socialism v. Capitalism and the Fair Tax. Solution.

Recently there have been reports of various polls that show Biden leading Trump for 2020. I find this hard to believe. One need only look at those attending their respective political rallies. Mr. Biden attracts token audiences while President Trump attracts 20 to 30,000. To clear up the matter, we will be conducting our first candidate poll in the historic district on June 1. We will ask the public who they prefer, Donald Trump or Joe Biden?

Mark Levin has been on the circuit selling a new book entitled "Unfreedom of the Press". In the process of promoting his book he has raised a concept I find interesting. When thinking about the First Amendment right to a free press, the general thinking is that the press has a right to publish without interference. But Levin has been suggesting that the people have a right to a free press.

It should be clear to everyone who has been paying attention to politics over the last 10 years that there is no free press. The concept of fake news, over the last two years, has been completely understood by the public. The only news source today is on the Internet. And there is so much disinformation as well as information to sort out. And, the browser giants on the Internet such as Google, Facebook and the likes are busy manipulating who receives what material.

But it goes further than that. Websites and organizations are not always what they appear to be. Early on in my publishing activities, I used to post Town Crier articles in other venues. One of those was Examiner.com. Examiner.com no longer exists. However, back in its glory days, I was an examiner,

more commonly called a reporter for the publication and I posted Town Crier articles on it. I posted over 245 articles. When you Googled my name there were pages and pages of listings. As you know I wrote about our Town Crier activities but I was also very critical of both political parties.

It seems that the owner of Examiner.Com, at the time, was a reclusive, eccentric, billionaire who is a political and religious activist. He often donates to the Republican establishment, much in the same way that the Koch brothers do. His name is Phillip Anschutz. He also owned the Weekly Standard. I think it's safe to categorize him as a GOP neoconservative.

When I first started posting I received little attention. But over time I reached a point where I was in the top five in the Jacksonville market, 13 in the regional market and in the top 50 nationwide. This was significant because there were different categories on Examiner, com and they were all merged for the ratings game. Entertainment reviews tended to be more popular than political news and commentary. When I reached some degree of success on Examiner, I attracted attention.

One day I got an email advising me that my material was no longer relevant to their purposes. In an instant I vanished from the Examiner Internet. I was advised not to tell anyone of this action. I immediately disclosed the occurrence.

A similar situation occurred on Tea Party Nation. Tea Party Nation had a following, as I recall of about 90,000. It was listed in the top five by the Washington Post for conservative postings and in the top 12 by the National Journal. It was created by Justin Phillips.

Nearly every Town Crier article that had a national point of view was published on Tea Party Nation. That is until Donald Trump came into the picture. Articles about Trump were rejected. Then all articles were rejected. Justin Phillips became a arch "Never Trumpster". In the end Phillips reorganized the website and the membership went from 90,000 to damn near zero. Today there are 120 members of which I am one. I'm never published.

I offer these two examples only to illustrate how freedom of the press works.

A free people cannot govern itself without accurate information. That's why our founding fathers included freedom of the press in the first amendment. And that's why the New World Order people insist on controlling the media.

People's right to the First Amendment is being denied.
