

In his rush to control guns, he will make criminals out of vast numbers of the population of New York.” Something new this week is the addition of the ‘Molon Labe’ flag pictured here. After concluding their activities on St. George Street, the Town Criers decided to go to Castillo de San Marcos for a ‘photo op’ with the new flag.

Second Amendment meets First Amendment.....




Going to the Castillo de San Marcos is a change of governmental jurisdiction. The City of St. Augustine has seen fit to permit the Town Criers to avail themselves of their First Amendment rights under the Constitution of the United States. However, the Federal jurisdiction is a different matter. The Town Criers, over a period of time, have been confronted by Park Rangers for carrying flags and signs onto Federal property. Even though, today, there were only two people and two flags for the 'photo op', the park authorities were quick to point out that 'free speech' was only allowed in their designated area. According to the Town Criers, it should be noted that free speech is not allowed on any of the paved sidewalks in the park. These severe restrictions on the First Amendment are offensive to the majority of the general public. Accompanying the two Town Criers was a member of 'Oath Keepers' who wishes to remain anonymous. Having never experienced a direct assault on free speech before, the Oath Keeper, while maintaining respect, pointed out to the Park Ranger that the imposition of these regulations was a violation of his oath to preserve, protect and defend the Constitution. The dialogue between the Oath Keeper and the Park Ranger lasted for about five minutes. During that period



of time, spectators who were present clearly sided against the Park Ranger. One man shot a video which, he announced, he was going to place on U-tube. The right of the people to free speech and to peaceably assemble is not something that is to be given by government when it is convenient. There are Supreme Court cases giving some credence to the federal authorities action. It is clear that the Supreme Court is complicit in undermining the American people's inalienable rights as expressed in the 'Bills of Rights. Nothing in Article III of the U.S. Constitution gives them this authority. Conversation with witnesses to the event, after the ranger left, revealed a deep anxiety among the people. The challenges to the emotionally charged First and Second Amendments are clearly awakening the American people, according to the Town Criers.


Sheriff Shoar Addresses 'Gun Control' at Republican Club

David Shoar, Sheriff of St. Johns County, Florida, addressed the Republican Club of St. Johns County on February 11, 2013 at the Shrine Club in St Augustine, Florida. He spoke on the subject of the 2nd Amendment and 'Gun Control'.



Sheriff Shoar is an excellent speaker and a self proclaimed Constitutionalist. Sheriff Shoar presented his position on 'gun control' using anecdotal stories and wit to make his point. To begin, he told the captivated audience that, often, people come up to him and ask, "Do you support gun control?" His answer was, "It is not about gun control, it's about government control". He used the example of Fast & Furious, where the Federal Government gave assault weapons to a 'drug cartel 'so that they could track them. "Everyone knows the outcome. It was a disaster," he said.

Sheriff Shoar answered every question with a real life experience. For instance, the sheriff spoke about the "University of Drug Dealers" where, according to his life experience, a local youth is caught selling drugs on the street corner, goes to jail (the University of Drug Dealers) and comes out a hardened criminal who eventually dies in a shoot-out on some corner. With a bit of sarcasm, the Sheriff said, "The Federal government does a great job but comes up short a lot, as in the Fast & Furious example".



He also said, "I'm a bit skeptical about talk of gun control and gun laws from a government that gave us Fast and Furious." He was asked what he would do if Homeland Security came to St. Johns County and demanded that the citizens of St. Johns give up their guns, and if he would comply. The Sheriff said "No. It is your Constitutional right to bear arms." And, he left it at that, making reference to calling a posse.

Also in attendance was a local troop of Boy Scouts. It was reassuring to many in the crowd that the patriotic values of the past are still being instilled in our youth today. The Boy Scouts, saluting the flag, recited the Pledge of Allegiance. They also raised their right hands and pledged to uphold the Boy Scout values of being prepared, duty, excellence, and helping of others. The Boy Scouts were in attendance as an action of civic responsibility toward earning that particular merit badge.



The Annual Conservative Political Action Conference, CPAC announced that Sarah Palin will speak at the 40th Anniversary gathering of conservatives in March. On January 16, 2013, Obama issued 23 executive actions against our Second Amendment right to bear arms. In response, Dustin Stockton organized a national protest for February 23, 2013. The reason d'être for the Fed in 1913 was to "provide the Nation with a safer, more flexible,



"The true purpose of the Fed is to allow Congress to spend money without limit without having to raise taxes and to allow the banking cartel to receive interest on paper assets that are created out of thin air. How much money is the Fed printing out of thin air this month? Forty Eight Billion Dollars (\$48,000,000,000) this month and each every month for as long as they want. This money is mixing in with your money and making it worth less and less. This is called inflation. What is inflation? Prices going up and buying power going down, that's inflation. Money is worth less because there is more of it, until it becomes "worthless," Mr. Baughn said.



Mr. Steve Baughn's remarks above were just some of the comments given in the presentation. Mr. Baughn concluded that, "1913 was a very busy year for the Jekyll Island Club of International Bankers who gave us the 'Christmas Present of the Fed' you know the gift 'that keeps on stealing from us' with every paper (fiat) dollar it prints."

As a parting shot, Mr. Baughn reminded the group that the Income Tax was instituted, because the 16th Amendment was passed in the same year! The well attended meeting was appreciative of Steve Baughn's message and tarried long after the meeting was concluded.
